For almost two years now, König-mtm has been providing its trainees with an environmentally friendly trainee car for continuous business and private use.

A special highlight is that all 25 of the company's apprentices took part in a creative competition to create the visual design of the BMW i3's exterior. This took place under the direction of production coordinator Alexander König. The design of the exterior of the electric vehicle is based on the most creative ideas of the trainees. In addition to the company logo, pictograms from the world of metalworking, such as gears, turning tools and callipers, document that the apprenticeship as a metalworking mechanic is a top priority at König.

Criteria were defined for the use of the eco-friendly trainee car, which include a high level of motivation in school and enthusiastic work in the company. The vehicle design is so harmonious, not least because the colours used - blue, black and white - reflect König's corporate colours.

Alexander König is convinced that "especially in rural areas, mobility is important for a professional career". Therefore, it is particularly important to him that "König-mtm would like to support those who distinguish themselves through special motivation during their training".
